● APPLICATION ELIGIBILITY

1. Those who are at least 18 years old at the time of application
2. Those who have completed the equivalent of 12 years of schooling in Japan in a foreign country
(*Those who are deemed to have the same or higher academic ability as above)
3. Those who have passed or are expected to pass the Japanese Language Proficiency Test N5 or higher or equivalent at the time of application, or those who have completed more than 150 hours of study at a school or language institution, etc.

● **ATTENTION**

- ✓ The optional exam fee is not refundable for any reason.
- ✓ If you receive a Certificate of Eligibility but refuse a visa, you will be refunded the tuition and textbook fees. However, if you are unable to enroll for personal reasons, the balance will be refunded after deducting 80,000 yen. (The remittance fee will be borne by the applicant)
- ✓ You are obligated to join the National Health Insurance. Please apply at the window in the urban area where you live and pay the insurance premiums individually.
- ✓ The applicant will be notified immediately upon receipt of the Certificate of Eligibility issued by the Immigration Bureau.
- ✓ After receiving the notification, please pay all the fees for the first year. After confirming the payment, a certificate of eligibility and admission permit will be sent.

● **IMPORTANT**

- 1 . After entering school, you may work part-time according to the criteria for activities outside of your status of residence, as long as it does not interfere with the school curriculum.
- 2 . National Health Insurance is compulsory to join and the school is not responsible for any problems such as illnesses that occur without participation.
- 3 . If a student withdraws for personal reasons, tuition fees, etc. will not be refunded.
